



Motrin® (Ibuprofen) Dosing Chart

We understand that Motrin® (ibuprofen) dosing can be confusing. At CHOC, we recommend that children take the amounts below according to their weight or age. Remember to read labels carefully, double check the concentration and dose before giving it to your child and ask for help from your pediatrician or pharmacist if needed. **Ibuprofen of any form is not recommended for children under 6 months of age.**

| 48-59 lbs. | 6-8 years | | 10 mL | 2 tablets |
| 60-71 lbs. | 9-10 years | | 12.5 mL | 2½ tablets |
| 72-95 lbs. | 11 years | | 15 mL | 3 tablets |

****If your child's weight falls in a different age category, base the dose on the weight, not the age****

Key: lbs. = pounds, mL = milliliters
